**HEALTH HINTS**

**YELLOW FEVER**

Yellow fever is an acute, infectious paroxysmal disease having three stages: the febrile, the remittant and the stage of collapse.

Yellow fever is communicated by the bite of a mosquito which has previously become infected by the parasite causing the disease. The mosquito becomes infected by biting a person suffering from the disease and thus becomes the agent of spreading the infection by biting other persons. The indications for treatment must be met as they arise and the service of a skillful nurse is necessary. But as this is considered a southern disease, we scarcely come in contact with it in this country.

**TYPHUS FEVER**

Typhus fever is an epidemic fever, acute, infectious and highly contagious. The patient must be isolated. The disease is rare in this country or in the United States. Nursing much the same as typhoid fever.

**MALARIAL FEVER**

Malarial fever is an intermittent fever—a term applied to a group of diseases that are due to an infection by a minute animal parasite which is found in the blood. This fever comes on periodically and there is no way in which the disease can be transmitted directly from one person to another. The disease is characterized by paroxysms of recurrence at frequent intervals. The patient is a few days sick, then quite well again. It is explained, the invading parasites pass through a regular period or cycle of development and reproduction varying from 24 to 72 hours and in reproducing themselves at these stated periods, cause the paroxysms of the fever. In time one can throw it off, but one must be doctored up for some time by a physician to do so. When these attacks come on the patient should remain in bed and rest, both mentally and physically. Treatment of chills and fever has been given before in these writings, or else the physician will tell you if you ask him, for chills, need heat and fever needs the cooling effect applied to the body.
