The British Preference
Calgary Herald (Nat. Cons.): The U.P.A. party in the Commons in a sub-committee in the budget advanced still further reduction in the duty on goods imported from Great Britain. Public sentiment in the Dominion is largely behind this policy. The present long-entrenched character of Canada's foreign trade demands that immediately steps be taken to produce a remedy. The Dominion is buying goods from the United States to a value of more than \$200,000,000 a year, but selling only one-third that amount in return. Great Britain is Canada's best customer. Dog Poisoners

The Meanest Kind of Human Crawling on the Earth To-day

That the work of the dog-poisoners does not always stop with the dog has been proved by a recent case in Toronto, where a young girl was made seriously ill by drinking water from a pail from which a poisoned dog had drunk. The dog, a valuable purebred, had picked up the poison outdoors, probably some that had been placed purposely. Then he went home, and, becoming ill, drank from the water pail in the kitchen. He was found dead in the house. The children game home, and one child took a drink from the pail and became very ill.

Dog-poisoners usually belong to the class of people mentioned in the old ditty:

The dog-haters hate to see a happy dog, it makes them think of strychnia, bi-chloride of mercury, etc. Whatever their opinion may be, they should keep it from taking form in action, for poison often reaches much farther than intended. Like evil thoughts, it carries far afield, and does not stop at the boundaries laid down for it. A bit of poisoned meat might be picked up by a small hungry child, in which case it would go hard with the poisoner if discovered. Even a dog-poisoner would hesitate to murder a child—although we should hate to trust him too far—and to find that his destructive deed had gone beyond its mark, and brought grief to a household, far beyond the loss of a dog, would be something to be remembered, even if he were never found out.—Humane Pleader.

Migration to Australia

Kenneth T. Henderson in the London Contemporary Review: A population of six millions cannot "digest" migrants by the hundred thousand, especially migrants with little or no capital, and therefore with little or no power for waiting opportunities or opening up independent fields of self-sufficient activity for themselves. A new and undeveloped country requires a certain power of initiative in its migrants—a power resident both in the character and skill of the individual and in the capital owned by him or lent him by the Government. That Australia will one day support from six to ten times her present population is estimated by economists, but her rate of absorbing newcomers can only increase more or less in proportion to the increase of her wealth and population. Meanwhile, Australia's population is increasing by about 2 per cent. annually—faster than that of any country in the world except New Zealand.
