ientists at this time, when they are seking for organic compounds to take the place of arsenate, which leaves an undesirable residue.

Demand for organic insecticides is much greater than the supply, according to Dr. R. C. Doark, of the Department of Agriculture. The most widely used materials in this class are flowers. Nicotine is derived only from the stems and floor sweeping of tobacco. Pyrethrum flowers are grown to a limited extent in California, but virtually all of the 11,000,000 pounds used annually in this country is imported from Japan. This plant is grown in the United States, but the cost of harvesting the flowers is a decided handicap to its production.

Rotenone has been obtained mostly from the roots of derris, a plant grown on the rubber plantations of Sumatra and the Malay Peninsula. Another promising source of retenone is 'cube," a wild plant which grows in the mountains of Bolivia. The Indians of those countries use the roots of this plant to poison fish. Small amounts of the plant thrown in streams stun the fish sufficiently for the natives to catch them with spears or nets.
