

Broadly speaking, the 1930 crop is handicapped by a deficit of 4 inches of rainfall, which it should now have in reserve for the growing crop in June, July and August. Forty-two per cent of the wheat this year is sown on fall and spring ploughed land and stubbled in. Even a good normal rainfall during the growing season will scarcely render plant food available in sufficient quantities to meet the needs of a rapidly growing crop in June and July. About 50 per cent. of the wheat is seeded on summer- fallow.
