MOTOR NOTES

One of the strangest and most expensive highways in the world is a five mile stretch in the southern part of Colorado. It contains \$15,000 worth of virgin gold, \$3,000 worth for every mile. The precious metal found its resting place by reason of the fact that the crushed rock for the cement mix was shipped from the ore dumps of the Cripple Creek gold field. The gold in this material assayed \$1.50 to the ton, and 2,000 tons were used for each mile of road.

A pageant portraying progress in automotive engineering to be produced on 200 theatre stages, each of which will be twice as large as the stage of an ordinary theatre, all housed in a gigantic building, has been proposed for the World's Fair to be held in Chicago in 1933.

Living models would tell, by voice and action, the whole story of the automotive engineering, each of the 200 stages to be given over to a phrase of the science.

Between each of the stages a moving picture screen would be located on which films would be shown with a view to furnishing continuity between the various stage scenes.

In Middlebury, Indiana, a motorist who had kept his car in storage during the winter, finding that his motor failed to start the first day he wished to use it, concluded that there was something radically wrong "inside the motor—there was."

Taking off the cylinder head he found that corn was packed solidly around the valves and in the exhaust manifold. Mice had used the motor for a home as well as storehouse, entering through the muffler and exhaust pipe.

The greatest menace to safety at night, the lightless vehicle, will be banished from the main highways of Manitoba under a provision of the new Highway Traffic Act of that province. The new regulation will be enforced only on provincial truck highways and such other highways as are designated by order-in-council.

In an effort to popularize the motor vehicles and to interest the citizens in good roads, an automobile trip of 120 miles was recently made between Shanghai and Hangchow, China, in 10 days. Traveling through sections where no automobiles had ever gone before, the lone car and party passed through two cities of more than 50,000 people, none of whom had ever seen a car.

Some suspected it of being possessed with "devils", others called it a road tiger, and still others a "leaping frog" because of the way it bounded over the roadless land. Oddly, the natives were very little interested in the motive power of the car. On the other hand, they had to be restrained from blowing the horn for hours at a time.

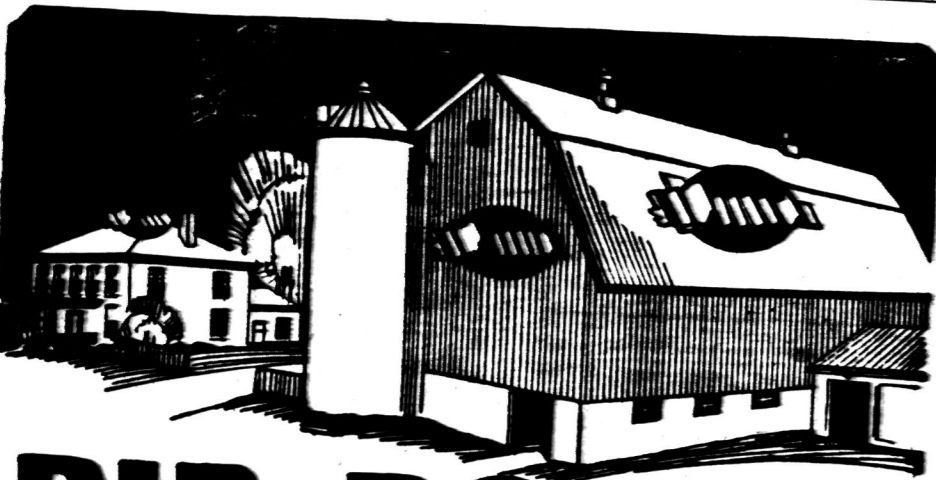
