

Lord Melchett TO PINK PILLS And Unempoyment

The question of unemployment dominates politics to-day, not only in Great Britain, but also on the Continent and in America. Under the title, "The Old and the New Socialism: Remedies for Unemployment," Lord Melchett shows in the April number of the Windsor Magazine, London, what we may fairly hope from rationalization.

Opce rationalization is fully carried out," he argues, "the old foolish controversy between 'Socialism' and 'Capitalism,' 'pffvate' and 'public' enterprise is wiped out altogether, since no reforms of a political nature could increase efficiency when it is already on the highest standard.

"The second important consequence which I anticipate as an ultimate effect of rationalization is the eventful elimination of unemployment. Unemployment, as we all know, is always due to maladjustment, to the unsatisfactory adjustment of production to consumption. Before the way this maladjustment was due to the periodical cycles of good and bad trade; but since the war it is due also to some other causes, such as the rearrangement of British industry to face the conditions of war and the difficulties of its re-adjustment to conditions of peace; the creation of national industries in many countries during and after the war, involving a fall in demand for British goods.

"If rationalization succeds in achieving anything, it is the complete adjustment of production to consumption and the elimination of those jumps


