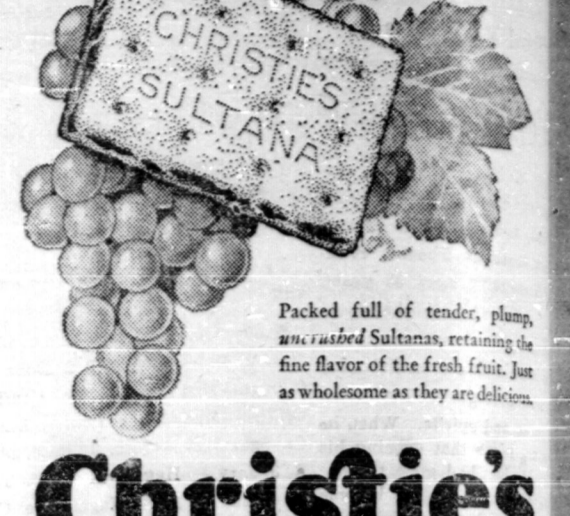

Vancouver Sets January Record

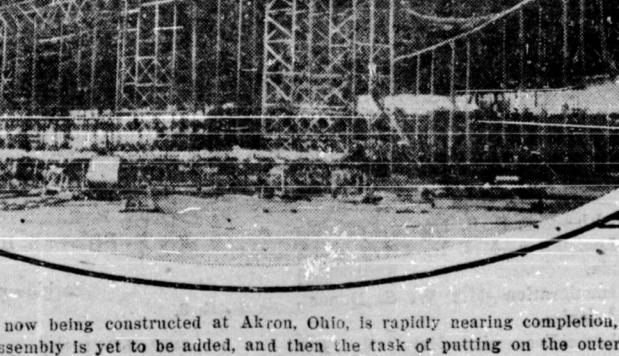
Highest Average Temperature Recorded in Last 25 Years

Dayton Beach, Fla.—Captain Malcolm Campbell's greatest ambition is to drive an automobile 300 miles an hour.

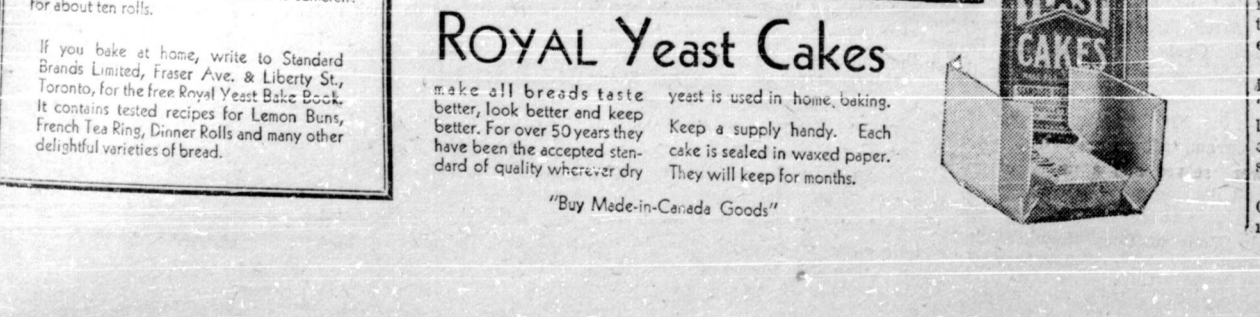
"I have said that I am not satisfied with my present record of 245. That is true, but I do not consider this a record. I have a desire to make preparations for his return trip to England.
