Greenland is the largest island in the world—a great pear-shaped mass 1,500 miles long and something like 900 miles broad across its upper bulge. It is the classic example of the glacial age. Except for its rocky fringes and the southern tip, it is buried in fee. The depth of the mammoth frosting is conjectural; but along the coast 2,000-foot cliffs are literally dwarfed by the fee-dome rearing back of them more than 9,000 feet into the sky.
