Every little while someone discovers a new and delightful way to curtain some north or poorly lighted window, so that the effect of light and sunniness is brought into the room. A very successful window curtain and drapery, which brought an appearance of sunshine and a suggestion of a flowery garden into a dim and cheerless north room, is here described.

The single window, which was about two feet free the corner of the room, was covered with a glass curtain of cream net, reaching to the window sill. It hung moderately full, its width being once and a half the width of the window. On this curtain, at one side, were appliqued gay-colored flowers with leaves and long stems, all made of silk that permitted the light to shine through brightly, as through steined glass. 


