not in a position to purchase such plants as Petunias, Zinnias, Marigolds, Cosmos, Asters, Tomatoes, Cabbages, Cauliflowers, Cucumbers, Lettuce and similar things, a hot bed is essential. The construction of such an affair is, neither difficult nor expensive, and in addition to growing such plants as the above it may be used to produce early lettuce, cabbages, radishes and melons for the table. Secure a supply of fresh horse manure which has been turned frequently to prevent heating and mix with a good quantity of soil, turning over occasionally until ready to use. The hot bed should be located where it will be convenient for the person looking after it during all sorts of weather. Preferably, it should have some shelter from north or shabby. Select or prepare a well-drained site and make a pile of the manure eight inches deep, and when well pressed down. On top of this place a light frame of wood, with a window south.
