### Council Held Special Meeting

All Members of the Council Vote in Favor of a Plebiscite For Waterworks. Vote to be taken on Tuesday, September 22nd. Voting place in the Council Chamber, between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.

### Council Held Special Meeting

The Council met at the call of the Reeve for the purpose of disposing in some manner the question of a waterworks system for the Village. After considerable discussion the following resolution was submitted and unanimously carried. Moved by W. J. Elliott and seconded by Andrew A. Miller, that in the opinion of this council a plebiscite should be submitted to the voters of the Village of Jarvis as to the construction of a waterworks system within the said Corporation, and that the same be submitted on the 22nd day of September next, and that a by-law be prepared and read a first time.

### Council Held Special Meeting

Moved by F. W. Reichel, and seconded by Geo. W. Webb, that the by-law asking for a plebiscite of the voters for the construction of a waterworks system be read a second time. Carried.

### Council Held Special Meeting

### Council Held Special Meeting

The following is a description of the proposed Water System in the Village, can be financed. The total cost of the system, completely installed and ready for use, cannot exceed \$35,000.00. The tenders received from the various contractors aggregate \$31,741.41. Adding the Engineering costs will bring this to \$32,228.48, which allows approximately \$1,600.00 for incidentals.

### Council Held Special Meeting

The annual amount required to pay the interest and sinking fund on \$35,000 of 5% debentures is \$2,330 per year for 30 years.

### Council Held Special Meeting

In the proposed system there have been located 24 Fire Hydrants placed in such positions that every building in the Corporation limits can be supplied with adequate fire protection.

### Council Held Special Meeting

It must be remembered that every property owner will directly benefit by this greatly reduced fire insurance rate therefore every one is entitled to participate in paying to this needed advantage.

### Council Held Special Meeting

With this in mind, it is customary for all municipalities to charge what is termed a "Hydrant Rental" This varies in different places from \$25.00 to \$50.00 per hydrant, and is, of course, paid out of general taxes.

### Council Held Special Meeting

Presuming that Jarvis struck a medium and charged \$35.00 per hydrant annually in this way.

### Council Held Special Meeting

Various municipalities have different charges for water users, but let us presume that the Village found 150 users for their water and charged one dollar a month, or twelve dollars a year, for all the water they required.

This would then raise \$1,800 per year. Yearly Expenditure.....\$2,330.00 Income.....\$1,800.00
