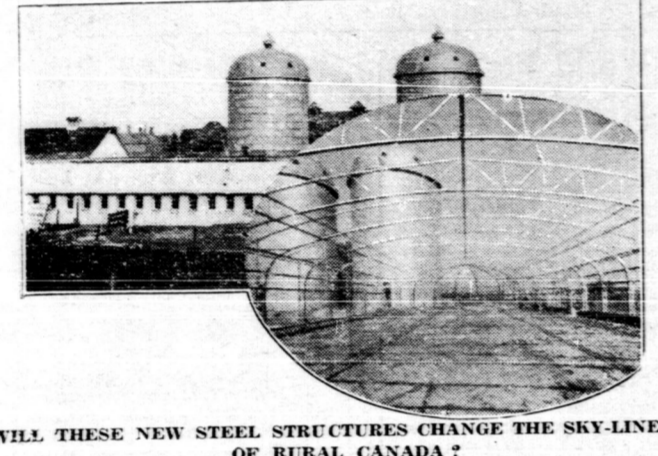

THIS WEEK ON PARLIAMENT HILL

Ottawa, December 10.—The capital turned its attention this week from a furor over the international angle of the Dominion's stand on the oil sanctions against Italy to the more domestic affairs on the agenda for discussion at the Dominion-Provincial conference.

The outcome of the important party meets with 15 Federal ministers and 50 provincial cabinet ministers here to exchange views on some of the most baffling problems facing the new government.

While the Federal ministers as well as the representatives from the provinces are hopeful that much will be accomplished before the present conference adjourns, it is thought likely that another gathering will be called by Prime Minister William Lyon Mackenzie King following the decision of the Supreme Court on the Bennett reform measures.

It was at first hoped by Mr. King that this information would be available for the present meeting. The Supreme Court will not sit until next month, however, and it may be some time before its findings are known.

Financial problems of the provinces and relief responsibilities, two matters closely related, head in tandem on the agenda. The Dominion and the provinces have all spent considerable time and effort in preparation and many of the provincial Premiers have come with programs of suggestions in their brief cases.

Difficulties which the mining industry faces and the need for uniform mining laws, touched on by Mr. King in his campaign, is expected to form one topic of discussion.

Trade Optimism

Optimism in government circles for increased trade possibilities continues to run high. Reports of a United States-British agreement have aroused enthusiasm here.

Revisions proposed in the present agreement between France and Canada have also aroused interest. The pact in force now, instituted by the Bennett Government, is regarded as highly beneficial to Canadian trade but it is thought that by some revisions it could be further improved.

On the other side of the trade picture is the fear of Canadian dairy farmers that the old bogey of New Zealand butter is to return. Butters from the Antipodes, it will be remembered, found a subject for many politicians in the 1930 election.

One of the leading debats in the forthcoming session of the House of Commons is likely to be that on the repeal of section 98. The Liberal party in its campaign advocated abolition of the section.

VIEWING THE NEWS

Battles Toll Tale of Science Washington—Battles bobbing on the waves of distant seas are aiding scientists here to gather knowledge on oceanic currents.

Ship Captains Have been encouraged by Government scientists to jot down their positions on a note with Washington, and it in a bottle and toss it into the sea.

The record of 10,000 miles was established by a bottle tossed overboard off Cape Horn, the southernmost tip of South America, in 1909.

The longest North Atlantic voyage of a bottle known is 9,000 miles, it was set adrift by the skipper of a Danish ship off Portugal in 1902 and four years later turned up near France.

Hydrographers studying the currents were convinced that it had been across the Atlantic and back.

New Immigration Plan Proposed London—An immigration scheme founded on sound business principles is being inaugurated between Britain and Southern Rhodesia.

A group of 12 skilled British miners will form the first stage of the contingent who will make new homes in South Africa.

High Commissioner Lanigan O'Keefe of Southern Rhodesia declares that his government while favoring immigration believes that it should be on business principles rather than on the basis of subsidies.

He says "There is a growing demand for southern Rhodesia minerals. Last year the output was valued at \$6,657,615. Made up mostly of gold. Twelve miners may employ a small contribution to the migration problem, but they are worth twelve specks anyway."

Mineral Wealth is Reported Edmonton—Expansion of the mineral development in Northern Canada is expected to result from the reports of surveys made this year.

A party of 32 geological students under Dr. F. J. Alcock checked and mapped the lake Athabasca region for the Department of mines.

Said Dr. Alcock: "The stuff is there alright. Whether or not it is of commercial value is the problem."

Transportation problems would not be difficult to overcome, he believed. Two other authorities also spoke optimistically.

Dr. D. F. Kidd, former government geologist and now working for private interests, spoke sparingly of his work during the summer, but freely admitted the presence of minerals in the north country.

Prospector Malcolm Campbell who has spent years in the great slave region which Dr. Kidd investigated predicts a northward gold rush in the spring.

Christmas Toys Go Modern New York—Toys have gone modern this year and manufacturers give assurance that dad will have more fun than ever when he gets down on all-four to play with the fruits of the Christmas tree.

The trains, long a favorite with the latest and most speedy locomotives and cars but this year they have whistles that actually send out shrill notes and wrecking cranes that can be rushed into action when dad or son becomes too enthusiastic.
