Ottawa, July 16—Canadian voters today are thoughtfully studying the 16-point reform program of the Hon. H. H. Stevens Reconstruction party.

The manifesto issued by the party is wide in its scope and is assigned, according to Mr. Stevens to strike directly at some of the fundamental problems of the Dominion.
