The most important of these conditions are sunshine, air, water supply, and especially the ability and opportunity of obtaining plenty of easily digestible food, or as it is referred to in the case of the plant, easily available food.

It should be the aim of the farmer to feed his soil in a form and manner which will permit them to be readily absorbed by the soil and plant.

Fortunately for the farmer, the majority of these soil foods are only required by the plant in minute quantities and most Ontario soils contain sufficient of them.
