1 cup boiling water

1 cup diced potatoes
2 cups canned tomatoes
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
3 tablespoons quick-cooking tapioca

Brown lamb and onion in butter; add water; then place in casserole. Cover and bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 1 hour, or until tender. Add remaining ingredients; cover, and continue baking 30 minutes, or until vegetables are tender. Sprinkle quick-cooking tapioca over top and mix carefully; bake 5 minutes longer. Serves 6.

8 cups soft bread crumbs or sifted dry bread
1/2 cup eggs
1/2 cup cocoa
1 1/2 cups melted butter
1 1/2 cups vanilla
Blend sweetened condensed milk with water; pour over bread crumbs or soft bread. Add eggs, cocoa, and melted butter. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 45 to 50 minutes. Baste frequently with fat that freezes out of top. Serves 6.

MANY USES FOR LEMONS

Many experienced housekeepers insist that they would give up lemons. Not only does lemon enter into the preparation of all sorts of dishes, but it has many uses in the kitchen and laundry.

Lemon juice added to sweet, fresh milk or evaporated milk will sour it suitably for cooking. Add quarter cup of lemon juice to one cup of milk. Lemon juice may be substituted for vinegar in any recipe that calls for the latter except in pickling. Tough meats will soon be made tender if you add a teaspoonful of lemon juice to the water in which they are cooked.

In the kitchen you will find that a lemon has many uses besides as a cooking agent. When aluminum ware becomes dull or black clean with a cloth dipped in lemon juice. Then rinse in warm water. After juice has been extracted, use lemon rinds to clean tarnished copper or brass. Dip the lemon rinds in salt before using to clean.

We have given so many hints for removing stains in which lemon played a leading part. If you will do well to laundry at home, do a great deal of laundry with a few lemons. Do not wash with a firm about 10 minutes. Chill in refrigerator.
