

One of the most important developments known to Lancashire for many years — and an indication of the faith of one of the world's largest concerns in the industrial tuture of Lancashire — is the announce ment that Meserz. Courtaulds, Ltd., are to built a huge rayon factory at Proston.

Messrs. Courtauld, six years ago, acquired about 340 acres of land at Ribbleton, near Preston, and it is on part of this site that the new factory is to be built. It is expected that the works, which will be the firm's larges single "unit" in Brital and will embody many new features, will be completed in about eighteen months' time.

Work will be found for about 2,000 workwell be found for about 2,000 workpeople at the start, increasing to 3,000 as the factory gets into full production. The firm expect to add at least 30 percent, to their production of viscose yarn with the new factory.
