Mr. James Robb spent the weekend at the home of his daughter Mrs. E. Drake, Hagersville.

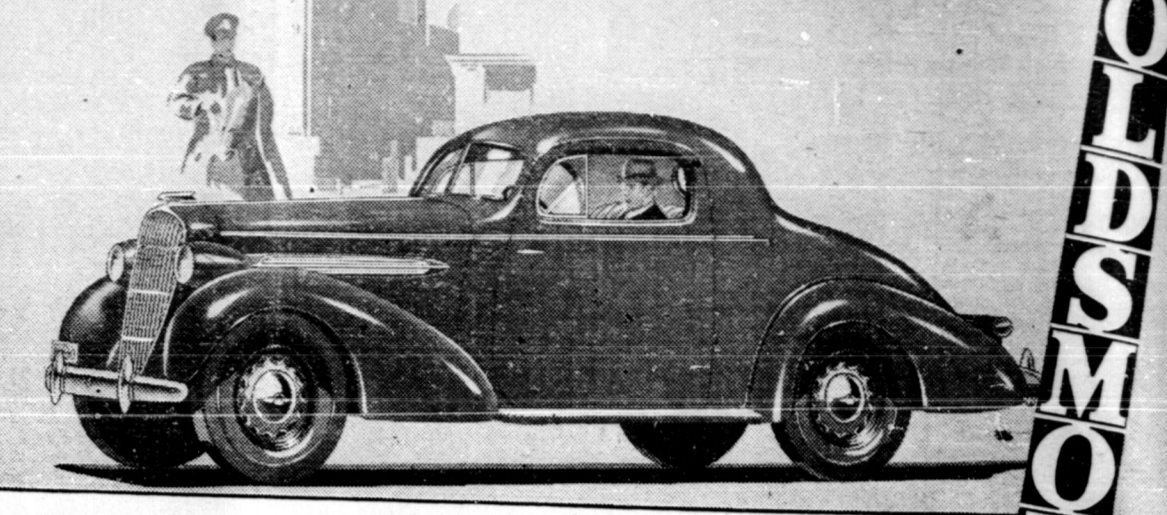
PORT DOVER

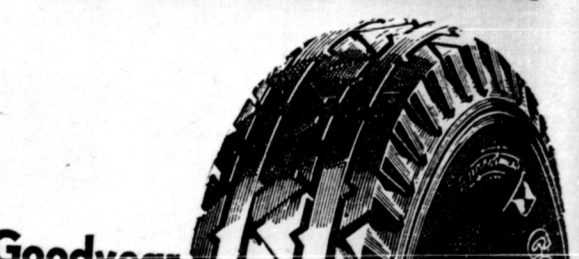
