SELECTING PULLETS FOR WINTER EGG PRODUCTION

Experimental Farms Note)

important factors contributing to a profitable poultry enterprise Winter egg production is influenced by breeding, feeding, health and general management of the flock.

At the Experimenetal Station, Fredericton, pullets are selected from high producing hens and males are used whose dams have been good winter producers as well as having a high total production. Pullets should be selected which are healthy well developed, vigorous and typical of the breed they represent.

Pullets of the heavy breeds should be hatched in April preferably about
