There are several cases in which everything else having failed we have been successful in procuring in cases where children have been deserted by their mothers, to care for these children and with the co-operation of the authorities in cities we have been able to locate the parents of such children and secure release of the permanent care.

THE ADOPTION ACT
During the past year 7 children were adopted legally, under the provisions of the Adoption Act. In some of these cases we are pleased to state that other homes are opening up for the reception of a homeless child.
