

the history of the mining industry of the Dominion at the annual meeting of the Canadian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, held last month in Montreal. This gathering really resolved itself into a convention of Canada's mining experts, the deliberations and discussions being of particular significance in view of the Economic Conference to be held in Ottawa in July. The papers read and discussed had for their chief purpose the consideration of Canada's position in mining and metallurgy in relation to the mineral resources of the Empire as a whole.

The central topic of this year's general meeting of the Institute was, perhaps, the paper read by Dr. Charles Camsell, Deputy Minister of Mines. Ottawa, entitled "Mineral Position of the British Empire." In this paper Dr. Camsell disclosed some interesting facts, based on a comprehensive study he has conducted during the past four years. It is no secret that the results from this study, presented at the last Imperial Conference in London, carried great weight with the members.
