## PLOWING MATCH

GREAT SUCCESS New Speed Class Won by Harold Porter

The 1932 Plowing Match under the auspices of the Haldimand County Association was this year held in the eastern part of the county which until this year had not had a match for some fifty years. The selected farm that of Mr. Roy Miller on the Rainham Road, provided ideal conditions for the many art. In the Tractor Class, Mr. Chris. Reichheld was awarded first prize in the men's class while the Richardson Shield in the boys' class was won by Mr. J. W. Richardson.

A new departure was the so called "speed" class in which case a given amount of land was to be plowed in a given time. The British Knitwear cup awarded in this class was won by Harold Porter.

A very successful banquet was held at night in the Women's Institute Hall with the Women's Institute doing the catering. Mr. James McLean spoke on behalf of himself and Mr. Stanley Tyndall as Judges and in a very clear manner gave his reasons for making certain placings and gave helpful criticism for the proper organization and running of the Match.
