E.B.—What kind of soil is best three acres of onlons next year. adapted for barley? Would you lime the land for this crop? What about the land for this crop? What about fertilizers for barley? I have a light siit loam field and have a clay field about the same size. Which would be best to use?

Answer.—Answering the last part of your question first it is generally claimed that lighter soils grow a better quality of barley for malting than do heavy soils. Heavy soils, however, have given the larg. Yield per acre in the co-operative tests which the Department of Chemistry, O.A.C., has conducted throughout the province during the last four years. In the last analysis, the yield of barley depends upon the physical condition of the soil and its supply of plantfood. In

In my opinion, the field you would choose would depend largely upon your object in growing barley. If you hope to sell it for malting purposes indications are that the light field would probably produce the better quality stock; if for feed, the clay field would be the preferable one.

It is not likely that the soil will need lime in order to prepare it for the growth of barley. However, if on testing your soil you find that it is acid in reaction, and if you wish to sow alfalfa or clover mixture with barley as a nurse crop, it would be well to apply the amount of lime that the test indicates desirable in order to have the reaction correct for the growth of legumes.
