PRUNING ROSES AND SHRUBS

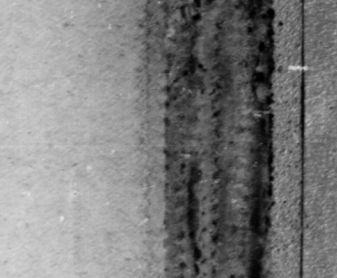
