VARIETY AT THE COMING ROYAL FAIR

Variety and novelty to a striking degree seem assured for the forthcoming Royal Winter Fair, a fact made plain by the enlarged number of Danville prize lists and catalogues containing new classifications which are now being mailed to thousands of exhibitors from the offices in Bay Street, Toronto. For the Royal really comprises "ten big shows in one," each appealing to widely different interests, yet bound into unity by being gathered in a 25 acre space—larger than many a Dutch or Belgian farm—under one roof.

The Royal Horse Show is now accepted as society's opening of the winter season for combined sport and fashion. It is in a class apart with no far as Canada is concerned, and finds its peer, this year, only at the smart New York Horse Show. An excellent program is being arranged with highly interesting special interludes.

Then cattle exhibits for both dairy and beef breeds are assured of keen competition from the United States. Not only are the best herds from the Middle West taking in the Royal at Toronto this year, but several are making a special point of their display because the Royal Winter Fair offers them the last opportunity to show their "All American Consents" which cover six or eight of the 17 American Fairs. All the Canadian breed associations with out exception prize first rate entries.

The same cherry prospects are being reported to the Royal Winter Fair; management for the exhibits of sheep, swine, poultry, pet stock (including rabbits, guinea pigs and fancy fish), fruit, flowers, seeds and grains.

The Royal Cat Show, which is carrying on traditions of the Canadian National Cat Club of Ontario, is this year's entry, and the officials of the Canadian Cat Council, under whose auspices the Royal Show is held, have the enthusiastic support of American cat fanciers in several states contiguous to the Canadian border.

A gratifying feature of the preliminary work is the despite drought and other adverse conditions Canadian agriculturalists, breeders and stockmen from Prince Edward Island to the Rocky Mountains are as prosperous years.

WEEKLY NEWS LETTER

Fall Planting of Perennials

Planning planting operations which are often put off until spring, may be done in fall with every hope of success.

No sweeping statement can be made about the growing country with such a diversified climate as ours; but in Southwestern Ontario where we usually have a long mild fall, perennials of many varieties can be planted at this time very satisfactorily. The soil is usually in excellent working condition in autumn—a condition which is often absent in spring—and if planting is done in early fall enough warmth will have been retained in the soil to encourage root growth, thus allowing the plants to become thoroughly re-established before freezing weather sets in. An established plant is better able to withstand summer drought than one newly planted; this is another point in favour of fall planting.

Late-flowering and tender varieties of perennials should be planted in early spring, but the early-flowering sorts give better results if planted in fall. The accepted time for planting iris seems to be July and August, although on this Station excellent results have been obtained by planting in October. This is not recommended as a general practice and we only follow it in the case of large plants transplanted and being divided. If the soil is at all dry at planting time, a thorough watering is advisable; although this is not often necessary, as in a normal fall there is a fair supply of moisture.

In the case of deciduous trees and shrubs it would be advisable to wait until the plants are dormant before transplanting; otherwise, the wood will not be properly ripened, which will entail the loss of a certain amount of vitality. Two very good reasons for planting trees and shrubs in the fall are: there is less danger of nurseries being sold out of the material required, and time is less fully occupied than in spring.

Transplants may be successfully transplanted during September, but late, unless the location is exceptionally favourable.

The Dominion Experimental Station, at Harrow, Ontario, will be glad to supply lists of plants which may be transplanted in fall and also planting instructions for these plants.
