### Negligence Is Not Recklessness

In Alberta, as in Ontario, there is a law which exempts motor drivers from payment of damages when gratuitous passengers are injured. Despite this law, a woman has been awarded damages against her brother by the Alberta courts. It seems, however, that the Alberta statute applied to injuries sustained by negligent operation, and the courts held that "negligence" did not, under the statute, cover recklessness. In Ontario, on the other hand, the Act says that the owner or driver shall not be liable, and makes no reference to either negligence or recklessness.

### Marked Increase in Employment

Employment in Canada, as indicated by Bureau of Statistics returns from 8,693 firms, showed a gain of 25,295 persons on June 1 as compared with May 1. The Bureau reports, in comparison with June, 1935, an increase of 47,721 was shown in the number employed.

### Butterfly Pictures New Fad

London's society's latest fad is pictures made almost entirely from butterfly wings. "B.P." the artist has been buying old collections of butterflies. He has completed a portrait of Queen Mary in the new medium. The dress consists of 600 butterflies, all taken from collections dated as far back as 1865. A striking portrait of Princess Elizabeth, entire, is being made. Excavations will be made in the Duchesse of York. Subjects that lend themselves particularly to this type of art are ships, angel fish, porcupine and coats of arms. Some of the costumes require 1,000 wings.
