**Favorite Biscuits**  
The old mummy-cooks inspired the legend of Southern hospitality by always serving the finest food. They were famous for their quick breads—flaky biscuits and delicious rolls.

**Down-South Biscuits**  
4 cups sifted cake flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon soda, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup lard, 1 cup buttermilk.  
Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder, soda, and salt, and sift gradually until soft dough is formed. Turn on floured board and knead lightly 2 minutes. Roll 1/4 inch thick, cut with small floured cutter. Bake in shallow pan in hot oven (450 F.) 12 minutes. Makes 2 1/2 dozen biscuits.

**Orange Marmalade Rolls**  
2 cups sifted cake flour, 2 teaspoons baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 4 tablespoons butter or other shortening, 4 tablespoons milk, 1 egg well beaten, 1-3 cup orange marmalade or preserved ginger, finely cut.  
Sift flour once, measure, add baking powder and salt, and sift again. Cut in shortening. Combine egg, milk and marmalade, mix to a soft dough. Turn on floured board. Knead lightly 2 to 3 minutes, roll 1/4 inch thick, and cut with 2-inch floured cutter. Butter 1/2 of each circle, fold in place on well-greased pan, and brush with melted butter. Let rise in warm place 15 minutes. Bake in hot oven (425 F.) 15 minutes. Brush tops with melted butter and finish baking. Makes 18 rolls.
