Miss Lydia Gruchy Has Ministered to Foreigners for Years—Overjoyed at News

MOOSEJAW—Miss Lydia Gruchy, who probably will become Canada's first ordained woman minister, is thoroughly British, although born in the suburbs of Paris. Her parents' home was on the Isle of Jersey. Pleasant, smiling, smart and fair-haired, she looks younger than her 42 years and was pleased, if not excited, when word came from Ottawa that the United Church was to be first in Canada to ordain women ministers.

She has conducted church services for years, principally among new Canadians in Saskatchewan settlements such as Insigner, in the Yorkton district, at Vergennes, Kansas, and Wakaw, Saskatchewan, Ukrainians and Hungarians have known her influence.

What does it cost to produce milk in Ontario? The milk producers of Ontario are to have an answer to this question in the very near future. Through the cooperation of the Economics and Dairy Husbandry Departments of the Ontario Agricultural College and the Dominion Branch, Dominion Department of Agriculture, a research staff is now engaged in this study.

Nova Scotia Coal

In 1941 over 2,000,000 net tons of Nova Scotia coal were sold in Quebec and Ontario being the largest amount on record since before 1913. This movement fell to 2,252,242 net tons in 1935, but preliminary figures for the first six months of 1936 hold promise of an increase even over the 1934 figures.
