Training Our Children to Take Their Place in the World. The following was prepared and read by Miss Francis Hubert, School teacher at S.S. No. 17 at the September meeting of the Parent-Teacher Association.

Training the Child should be such as has been said. That will develop the child physically, mentally, morally, and socially. Consider your child thoughtfully, carefully. Is he as physically fit as he should be for a child of his age? If not, is there anything you can do to make him stronger? Have you had him examined? Is he getting sufficient sleep and rest and sufficient food? Is he getting the variety of food necessary to build a strong body? Is he living in an environment that is cheerful and healthful? Consider your child mentally, and physically fit for what he is expected to do. See that there is no condition in the home to react in a stultifying or depressing system which will in turn react on his mental ability.
