ture of the Province of Ontario to pass an amendment to the Municipal Act prohibiting the council of any municipality in the Province of Ontario from passing any bylaw or resolution changing Standard Time to Daylight Time, and that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to all county councils in the Province of Ontario for endorsement.
And enclosing a second resolution which reads as follows: "This committee petition the Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Ontario to amend the Children's Aid Act so as to give the county council and the council of any city or separated town within the county, contributing to the funds of the society, power to appoint the members constituting the governing board of said society, and that copies of this motion be sent to the councils of counties and cities throughout the Province of Ontario asking their approval and co-operation."
12. Letter from the County of Simcoe, that they are holding a county forestation Field Day on Wednesday, August 11, 1937, to promote reforestation and asking for representatives from all the counties in the province. Referred to the Committee of the Whole.
