SCIENTIFICALLY TREATED

The most important factor in the care of tuberculosis is rest. If a natient has tuberculosis of a joint, the limb is put to rest by splinting or by some other means. The same method applies to tuberculosis of the lungs. In a certain number of patients the diseased lung can be put at rest by artificial pneumothorax or by other surgical operations.

In most cases, however, the only way to rest the lungs is to rest the entire body. This general rest reduces all muscular action, thereby saving energy with which to fight the disease.
