CANADA LEADS IN

RADIUM PRODUCTION

Radium is now being produced in Canada on a regular production schedule. After years of research and chemical processing the Eldorado Refinery At Port Hope, Ont., have so perfected their extraction methods that they are able to refine monthly an infinitisimal quantity. The story of Canada's great contribution to the world is told by J. A. Cowan, writing in the February is sue of The C-I-L Oval. Pitchblende radium-bearing ore, mined on the fringe of the Arctic Circle at Eldorado Gold Mines on the shores of the cancer.

Great Bear Lake, is shipped in special bags 3000 miles to the refinery where six tons of chemicals are required to refine one ton of ore, from which is extracted but a few milligrams of radium salts. Previous to the discovery of radium in Canada's great northwest the price or radium was \$70,000 per gram. Can adian enterprise has now reduced this to around \$30,000.

Fresh radium salts are sealed in a glass tube no thicker than a match and are kept in-holes drilled into a safe made from solid lead. The rays from radium continue for nearly 1,700 years and its most humanitarian use is in the treatment and acure of cancer.
