CANADIANS SPEND ON OUTSIDE GOODS: OWN PEOPLE SUFFER

Canada gave financial or other assistance to seventy-five out of every ten thousand Canadians in September, apart altogether from those who received aid from private charitable organizations.

This comparison was made in a statement issued today by the National Producers in Canada Association for the purpose of "showing away, at least, in which Canadians can, by insisting on buying Producers in Canada merchandise on every possible occasion, help to provide relief, which comes from taxes."

A study of the statistics issued by the Dominion government for the twelve months ending October, 1937, proves conclusively that Canadians are spending millions of dollars every week on necessities of life which are imported when they could obtain, probably, the equivalent which are produced or made in this country by Canadians.

After the classifications listed by a careful study of the statistics were such articles as furniture, clothing, shoes, drugs, medicines, handkerchiefs, hats, neckties, soap, fruit, vegetables, candy, sewing machines, radios, lamps, tools, paints, typewriters, farm implements and fertilizers, wood, paper, machinery, books, dolls, jewellery, newspapers and periodicals.

All these items were imported in large or small quantities in the twelve months ending October, 1937, yet a study of our own production and manufacturing figures indicates that in the end it evokes nothing but criticism and denunciation.

Beware The Demagogue!

PANDERING TO PREJUDICE AND PASSION the demagogue defies the law that guards his own life from the mob. He denounces the very power that protects him from annihilation.

THE OBNOXIOUS AGITATOR whose occupation is to appeal to cupidity or prejudice of the masses, is hard to suppress. He is always unreasonable, aggressive and vociferous.

HE SETS AUTHORITY AT NAUGHT, is impatient of restraint, and is an avowed enemy of organized society. He is resistant, violent, recalcitrant. At heart he is a rebel.

THE DEMAGOGUE spreads discontent and thrives on it. He exalts in his trade of trouble-maker. He is unprincipled, pugnacious, anarchistic. He is untrustworthy, bumpkin, despotic.

BIG TALKERS eventually talk themselves out. In Hyde Park, London, the police permit demagogues, anarchists, wranglers, factious orators and other reactionists to shout and harangue and vilify without interference. It is better, they claim, to let fire brands get it out of their system, than to go about with smouldering hatred within.

WORDY POLITICIANS have often talked themselves completely out of serious consideration. When a man talks himself out of breath, he talks his listeners out of patience, so that in the end it evokes nothing but criticism and denunciation.

THE WEAKNESS OF THE DEMAGOGUE is that his words are so big and the feasibility of his promises so small. He does not deceive intelligent men. Nevertheless he is a serious menace to society.

GREAT ORATORS may include challenge and invective, but the elements of earnestness and usefulness must dominate. Here self-consciousness is swallowed up in purpose, and unlike the selfish demagogue, the true orator brings his aid to the shrine of public utility.

THE WORLD NEEDS the services of educated men and women and the inspiration of high-minded leaders. It needs men like Mazzini, of whom it was said: "He has done a noble work for his country and his watchword 'God and the people,' is one that all nations must be the better for."

THE WORLD NEEDS men of sterner stuff, of unquestioned principle. In politics, business and law, it needs the pulpits, in science and education, it needs the consistent demand for men of high ideals.
