NOTICE

The Council of the Township of Walpole, hoping to improve the condition of roadsides within its jurisdiction in the township, have decided to alter their general policy in regard to weed destruction so as to permit payment for cutting of weeds. The rate for man labor is 20c per hour, and 5c for each team and mow. The responsibility for weed cutting will be placed on the property owner who will have the privilege of destroying the weeds on roadsides adjacent to his property at the regular rate of pay. If, however, the property owner refuses or neglects to destroy weeds at the proper time, it becomes the duty of the road foreman, who is appointed by and operates in accordance with the Road Superintendent in conjunction with the Township Council, to take such steps as are necessary to have said weeds destroyed as often as may be necessary to prevent ripening of same.

As council members, we realize that the destruction of weeds is a public duty and we are anxious to see that the co-operation of all property owners in the township in this splendid township of the weed menace.

The provisions and penalties of the provincial seed act are severe, but we do not anticipate the necessity of enforcing same if each property owner realizes the importance of this duty and takes the necessary steps to prevent the weed menace.
