« Strawberry Season Is Here »

According to government forecasts the strawberry crop will be a bumper one this year. The harvest has been retarded by the frost but it is expected that by the middle of June, supplies of strawberries will be plentiful. The first thing to do is to serve as much of this delicious fruit as possible, while it is on the market. The season is short so we have to make the best of it.

The following recipe gives you some idea of how jelly powder can combine with strawberries to make another delicious way to enjoy this fruit to your table. They are novel and easy to prepare.

Strawberry Shortcake

3 cups sifted cake flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 cup butter or other shortening
3/4 cup milk (about)
2 quarts strawberries

Sift flour once, measure, add making powder and salt, and sift again. Cut in shortening with fingers or use a pastry blender. Place in slightly floured bowl. Cut with 3-inch biscuit cutter. Place half of biscuits on baking sheet; brush with melted butter. Place remaining biscuits on another sheet and mix with fork only enough to make flour and together. Continue until all flour has been mixed in separate portions. Wrap in waxed paper. Chill thoroughly. Roll pastry to 1/8-inch thickness. Cut with 4- or 5-inch floured cookie cutter and fill carefully on outside of upturned tart or muffin pans. Trim edges. Prick with fork. Bake in hot oven (450 degrees F) 10 to 15 minutes, or until slightly brown. Makes nine 3 1/2-inch tarts.

Tart Shells

2 1/2 cups sifted cake flour
1/2 cup cold shortening
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 1/2 cup cold water (about)

Grants To Help Finance Roads Into Mine Areas

dominion Minister of Resources Gives Details of Assistance The Provinces will be given To Aid in Development of Mining Sections—Will Improve Transportation—Ontario to Get \$250,000

Resources Minister Crear last week announced tentative allocation of the \$1,000,000 fund for roads into mining areas. The supplementary estimates to assist the provinces in improving transportation into mining areas is that year's program as follows: Nova Scotia, \$25,000; Quebec, \$250,000; Ontario, \$250,000; Manitoba, \$225,000; Saskatchewan, \$125,000; Alberta, \$100,000; British Columbia, \$240,000; Northwest Territories and Yukon, \$83,000.

Do Investigate Before Buying

Methods of operation of the Toronto Stock Exchange, which he said, is a "much misunderstood institution," were outlined by Norman C. Urquhart, exchange president, to Kincaid business men at their spring banquet.
