National Defence Ottawa, January 31 - With the horizons of the world darkened by menacing clouds the government has decided to expand very substantially this country's system of defence against possible aggression. In the estimate tabled in the House of Commons by Mr. Dunning, Minister of Finance, the appropriations for defence for the coming year are nearly 30 million dollars above the year now coming to a close. The defence estimates totalled \$35,966,524, which was approximately the same amount as in the previous year. The total estimate for the coming fiscal year is \$63,447,275.

Wide Changes to be Made In Conducting School Fairs

As a result, School Fairs will be revamped and revised rather sharply and will continue as a province-wide project of the Department of Agriculture.

Municipalities Regain Solvency With Help of Municipal Affairs Dept.

It is hardly a case of "rags to riches" but the picture of municipal financing in Ontario has undergone a marked change since those dark days of a few years ago when municipalities of this Province were in default of many of their obligations. Today many of those municipalities which were unable to meet their contractual obligations are able to sell bonds bearing interest at 4% and 4 1/2% with a slight premium, in the open market.
