There is a marked trend towards Church unity today. In Canada we saw the wedding together of Presbyterians, Methodists and Congregationalists in the great United Church of Canada.

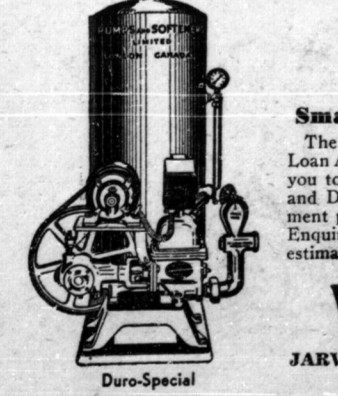


The old VILLAGE WELL

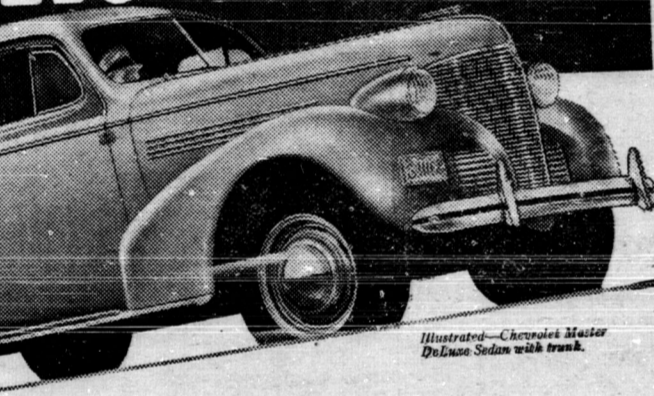
