To the United Fields. It spreads rapidly and com plete eradication is imperative. Badly infested pastures and meadows should be broken up and a short rotation with deep, thorough cultivation followed by a hoed crop, smother crop or grain crop. Do not reseed until this weed is eradicated. If proper cultivation is followed, it should be possible to kill this weed without the loss of a crop. Chemical spraying is recommended where cultivation is impossible. See your district weed inspector or write


