Always agreeable. Minister Power agreed further. Agreed that on answers to garbage can questions 3, 4, 5 & 6 the Department of National Defence could with advantage have stuck closer to truth.

No use to try to tell Mr. Hatfield M.P. in answer to questions 3 and 4 that 929 garbage cans shipped direct last March to military camps in Military District 7 (New Brunswick) when there were no camps in existence or announced in Military District 7 last March.

Note for future historians: Minister Power's initials are C. G. not G. C. for Charles G. G. for Gavan. Note for no reason in France they are called pouelles, after a dead Paris prefect of police. Here they are just garbage cans — G. for garbage, C. for cans.
