Seneca Party Political Broadcasts to Occupy 12¹/₄ Hours of Free Time on the CBC National Network

12½ Hours of Free Time on the CBC National Network

Following a two day session on January 31 and February 1 at CBC Headquarters in Ottawa, an agreement has been reached by CBC and the Canadian Association of Broadcasters with representatives of the four political parties whereby 12½ hours of free time will be provided on the CBC National Network during the Dominion election campaign There will be no paid party political broadcasting on CBC national or regional networks.

Paid party political broadcasting is to be confined to local and provincial distribution through privately owned stations except where, as in the case of Chicoutimi, the CBC station is the only outlet giving local coverage.


