partment of Agriculture, Toronto. This is Yellow Rocket, a perennial weed which appears in new parts of the Province each year and which is especially found in low, damp parts of the fields.

RESEMBLES MUSTARD
Upon close examination Yellow Rocket will be found to resemble Mustard only in the colour of the flower. It may be easily distinguished from this weed by its dark green, smooth and shiny leaves, somewhat oval in outline. It is usually in flower from May to July, and matures seed during July and August.

Hand pulling of scattered plants, drainage and thorough cultivation in preparation for a spring crop will keep it under control.

DON'T LET IT MATURE
The seed of Yellow Rocket is a common impurity in clover and alfalfa seed and has been listed as a secondary noxious weed in the Canada Seeds Act. This weed should not be permitted to mature seed, particularly in the clover seed producing areas.

It is distinguished Yellow Rocket and eradicate it before it becomes established, advises Mr. MacLeod.

Work Feverishly

In Eastern Ontario Most of Them Are Working at Capacity to Supply Foreign and Domestic Needs

A survey in the Eastern Ontario manufacturing district around Belleville indicated last week that practically all factories are working at capacity. District dairymen expressed belief they would supply at least a portion of the 75,000,000 pounds of cheese recently ordered by the British government, to be delivered at a set price of 14 cents a pound, each Montreal.

SWITCH TO UNCOLOURED
The effect of British preference for uncoloured cheese is noted on the Belleville board. A premium of 1/2-cent was offered for the uncoloured variety and this is believed to be responsible for many factories switching entirely to making uncoloured. Domestic trade, however, has always shown a marked preference for colored.
