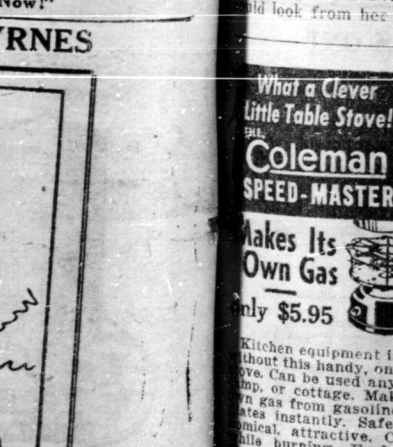
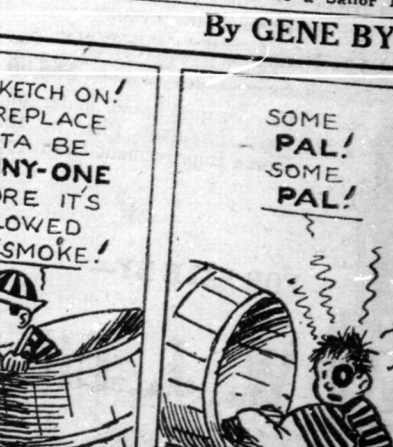
A new trophy, donated by E. F. Stephenson of New Liskeard for the best front page, was awarded to the Bowmarville Courier.

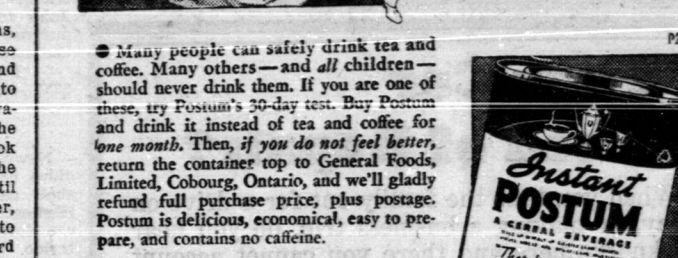
