The War Time Prices and Trade Board ordered on Tuesday that rentals in certain designated areas in Canada be pegged at the levels of January 21st, 1940, effective on and after October 1st.

The powers of the War Time Prices and Trade Board were extended to include the control of rentals, by an order-in-council on September 11 when it became known that excessive rentals were being charged in areas where the War Effort was being pressed, due to a shortage of accommodation.

The Ontario Municipalities designated by the Government include Allandale, Barrie, Kingston, and Port Huron; Ottawa, including East View, New Edinburgh, Overbrook, Rockcliffe, Westboro and Woodroffe; Parry Sound, Nottwil, Trenton, Windsor.

The Board is empowered to appoint local committees in designated areas for the purpose of investigating and adjudicating upon local complaints and applications respecting housing accommodations or rental.

Other areas in Canada not already designated by the Board will likely be added as the War Effort becomes more pressing and as the need for housing accommodations becomes more acute.
