Laundrying Your Candlewick Spread  
One of the most popular modern fabrics is candlewick. It's reasonable, it's attractive to look at and it comes in lovely colors. This is how to launder spread: Make some good, soapy water and plunge the fabric in, use a squeezing action to expel the dirt, but don't rub or wring the material. Rinse until the final rinsing water is clear (two or three rinsings of water as rule) and then hang outside until nearly dry. When the candlewick is almost dry, shake it as hard as you can to bring up the wick part, and when it is absolutely dry beat the whole surface with a light brush, a sort of dabbing, whisking action.
