How Can I?

Q. How can I make my teeth whiter?

A. Apply a solution of peroxide of hydrogen diluted with one-half water to the teeth.

Q. How can I cause paint to adhere to new tin?

A. Rub the surface of the tin first with pumice powder, or sandpaper, and apply a coat of zinc oxide before beginning the work.

Q. How can I clean white woodwork most effectively?

A. Heat a pint of milk in a pot of water, and then add one tablespoon of kerosene. Apply and polish immediately with a soft cloth.

Q. How can I remove shine from shoes?

A. Dip the shoes in a solution of vinegar before polishing.

Q. How can I remove perfume spots from my furniture?

A. Rub the spots with lime juice, or a solution of ammonia.

Q. How can I keep my kitchen sink free of grease and disagreeable odors?

A. Try pouring a strong solution of hot water and salt through the sink and drain at least once a week.
