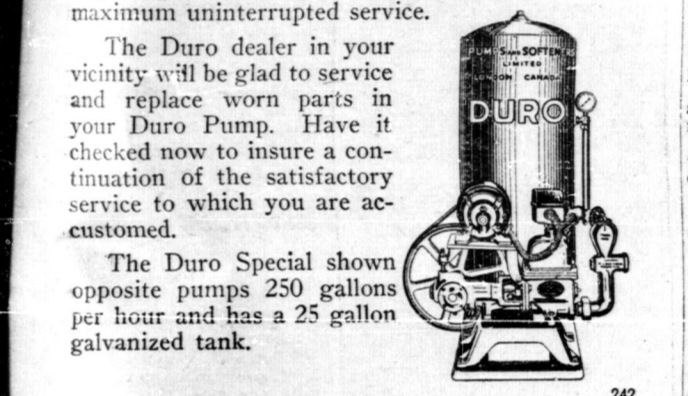

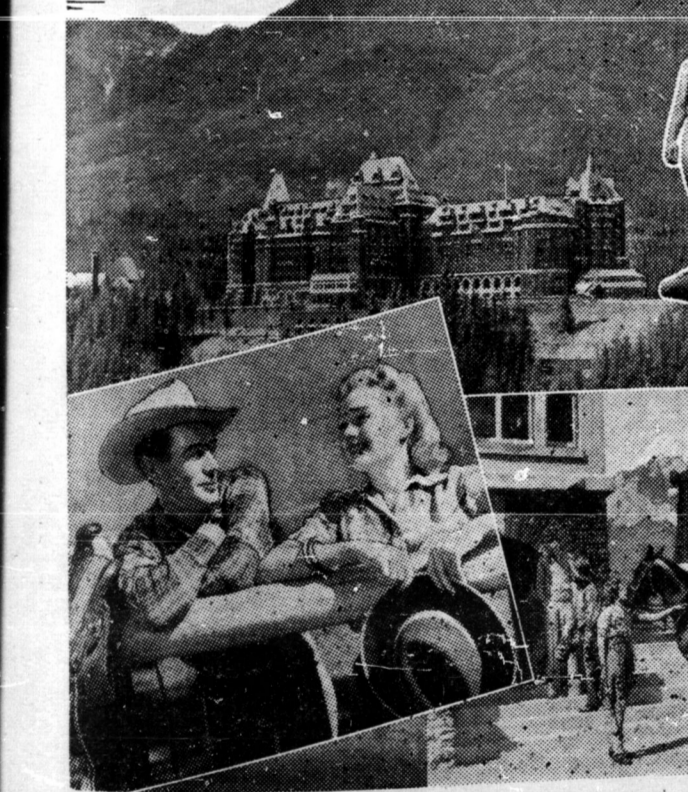
The Duro Special shown opposite pumps 250 gallon per hour and has a 25 gallon galvanized tank.
