The annual summer vacation is nearing completion for public school pupils. The Public School Board has announced that classes will start on Tuesday, September 8th.

Can I improve my pasture by adding fertilizer only and not reseed it? Yes. In the same test conducted at the Ontario Agricultural Experiment Station, a well fertilized, new seeded mixture, the results were amazing. For instance the untreated pasture gave 60 pasture days whereas the treated area gave 185 pasture days in an increase of 205 days. Likewise the total protein was 20.4% vs. 14.4% in the untreated pasture. The protein in the treated area was increased from 1.95% to 2.15%.
