agreements with Wartime Housing... The Ontario Municipal Board has agreed to sanction a plan whereby the city of Ottawa would conduct negotiations with Wartime Housing for the immediate erection of 200 houses in the war crowded capital.

The U.S. Market calls for a purity of not more than one thistle seed per gram. This is less than 3 of 1000 lbs. of bluegrass seed, most of it Haldimand County, during 1942.

What can we do about it? Well, you may not set about improving the crop. Why not? Because these bluegrass fields, this would improve the quality of seed.

Let us therefore give some thought to the parent stock of our seed crops. Let us stop dropping seeds of these fields of bluegrass, (save the seeds for the other fields too).
