Never allow horse to step on the rope and every care should be taken to keep the rope from dragging in the dust and dirt.

When longer than necessary, the extra rope should be enclosed in an old bag.

Unuse strain from extra heavy loads or severe jerking.

All pulleys are of the same size and should be kept in good working order. Do not allow rope to rub on beams or posts.
