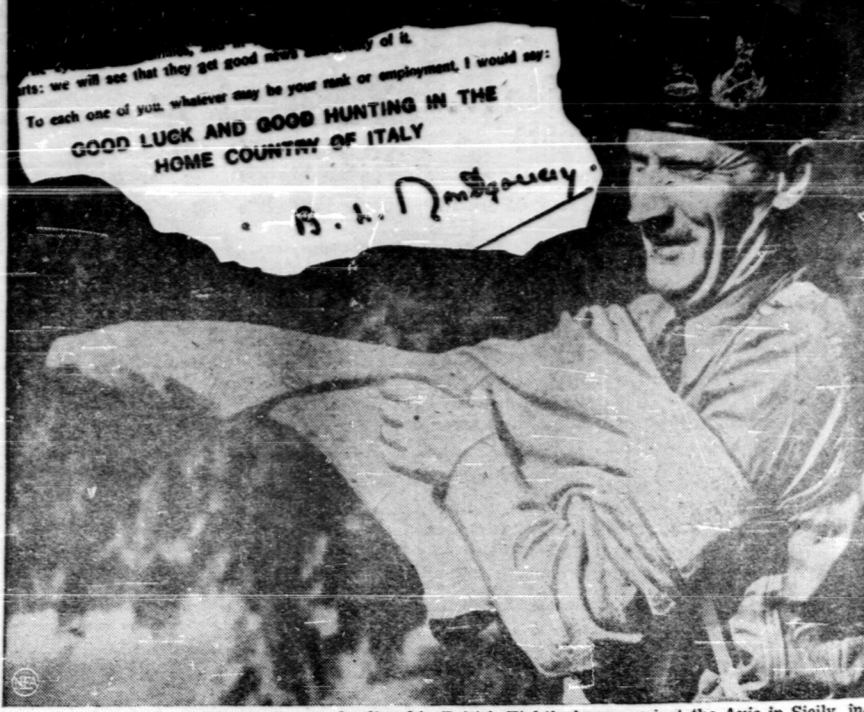


Message From Montgomery

A—Pass the blade of the bread knife through a flame to heat it, and there will be no difficulty in cutting fresh bread.

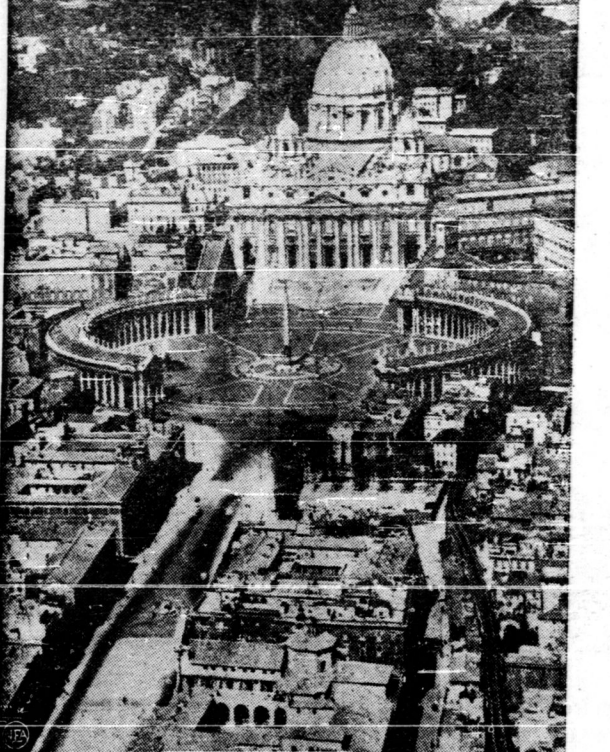

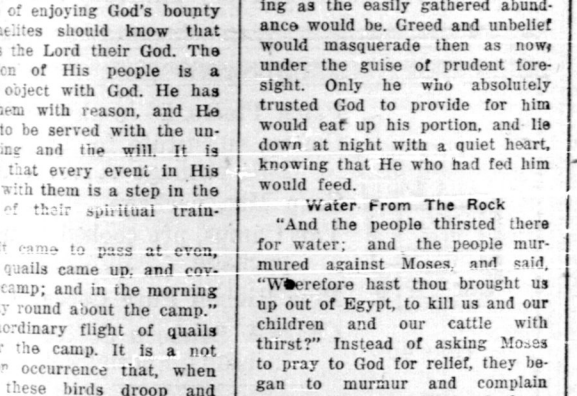

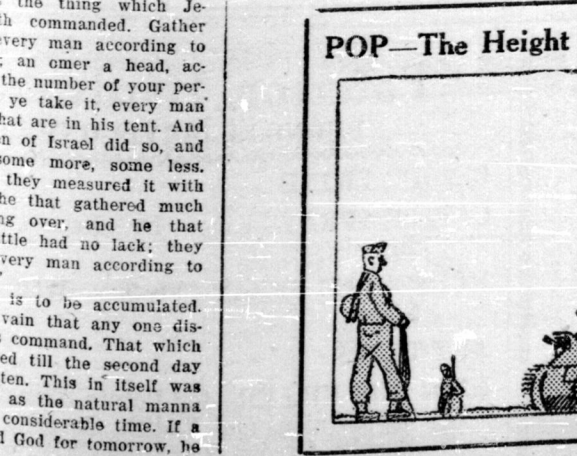

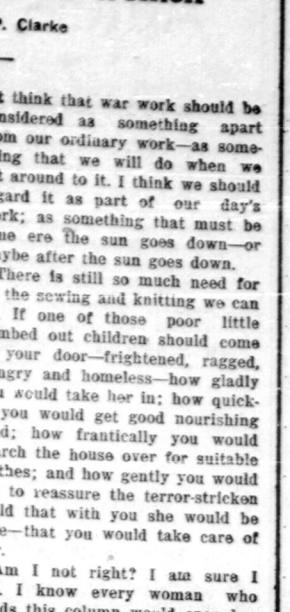
Maj-Gen. G. G. Simonds, 40, is commander of the Canadian Army's First Division now spearheading advances on the central front in Sicily.

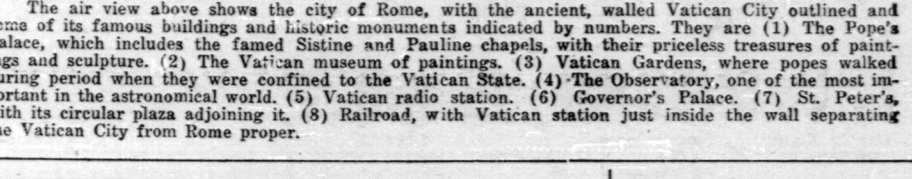

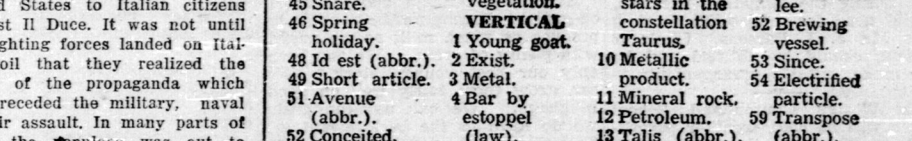
