On The Farm Front

Professor H. G. Bell gave some interesting data when speaking at the Annual Meeting of the Hamilton Crop Improvement Association last week.

In 1940 a test was conducted on the farm of Amers Brown near Canboro with fertilizer on Fall Wheat. The results were as follows: The results were even more striking on the farm of L. M. McInnes near Kahierville.

The development of the new hybrid varieties would seem very desirable to make it possible for farmers in Hamilton county to take advantage of this crop. Corn is the only grain crop not produced in excess of its needs in Canada.

Don't Rattle Milk Pails Till You're Ready To Milk. So read a head line in a recent issue of the Ontario Farmer. The article proceeds to urge that nothing be done to stimulate the milk market until the milk is ready to be milked.

A few other suggestions are given too. The cow should be treated gently at all times. A frightened animal will give less milk.
